Spain: Perpetual Profession



On September 24, 2022, Sisters Anita, Immaculate, Elena and Hilaria, made their Perpetual Profession, in the Generalate of Trinitarian Religious in Madrid. Each of them comes from a different place: India, Kenya, Spain and Guatemala, but they are united by a common passion: to follow Christ the Redeemer. 
India: Entrance to the Novitiate

Week of Prayer for Persecuted Christians.

From October 17 to 23, 2022, the worldwide spread Trinitarian Family conducted the week of prayer for our brothers and sisters who suffer for reasons of faith in many nations of the world. We report here the unfolding of this week in some of our communities.

Gagliano del Capo-Italy:



Father Pasquale Pizzuti, pastor of SAN ROCCO CONFESSORE Parish in Gagliano and head of SIT, with the collaboration of diocesan priests, especially DON Fabrizio GALLO, head of the OFFICE for Ecumenism, directed this week of prayer.

On Oct. 17, the effigy of the NAZARENE was received in the community of Gagliano where HOLY MASS was celebrated by the assistant parish priest Father Matteo Santamaria, who in his homily took up the origin of the devotion to Jesus Nazarene. The week of prayer ended on Sunday, Oct. 23, the feast of JESUS NAZARENUS, in the Basilica of Santa Maria di Leuca where the effigy of Jesus NAZARENUS RESCATTED was translated; H.E. Msgr. Vito Angiuli, bishop of the Diocese of Ugento Santa Maria di Leuca, presided at the Holy Mass.

Granby, Quebec-Canada



Canada. the cause of persecuted Christians was highlighted in a special way at the Day of the Elderly held on Wednesday, October 19, at the Granby home. Awareness was raised among those present at the Mass presided over by Fr. Michel Goupil, head of SIT Canada-France, who dedicated his homily to convey the information and talk about this reality of persecuted Christians. After the Mass there was a testimony by Emile, a Trinitarian layman who has been involved at the level of SIT Canada-France for many years.

In addition, there was a small exhibit on persecuted Christians highlighting the role and mission of SIT. People who attended this day were also able to visit the exhibition. To help fund the missions, it was suggested for those who wished to do so to support the missions by purchasing sweets or handicrafts prepared by the Trinitarian sisters.

Rome: Trinitarian Sisters.



During this week, the Trinitarian Sisters of Rome, together with the children, prayed daily for persecuted Christians; on Thursday evening the whole community gathered in the chapel for the Eucharistic Hour; while on Friday there was the Stations of the Cross for persecuted Christians and on Saturday the recitation of the Holy Rosary with meditations from our brothers and sisters who face suffering and pain because of their faith in Christ.

Blessed Dominic Iturrate Vicariate (Colombia-Porto Rico)

Responding to the SIT's constant call to spread the reality of Persecuted Christians and to pray for them, the Blessed Dominic Iturrate Vicariate celebrated the Week of Prayer, developing various activities aimed at achieving the two aforementioned goals. Thus communities, formation houses and parishes wanted to join in this unanimous prayer and become aware of how so many brothers suffer persecution and martyrdom because of their faith in Christ.



Among the activities that took place were the recitation of the Holy Way of the Cross, the Rosary, the Holy Hour, and the Eucharist on the Feast of Jesus the Redeemer; as well as altars, drama works, and outreach in social networks. More to be done so that every day we become more aware of this reality and thus can make visible the situation that our Christian brothers and sisters live in so many parts of the world.



MEXICO

Italy: Pastoral visits of the Minister General


