#### Italy: Feast of Blessed Anna Maria Taigi

The feast of Blessed Anna Maria Taigi was celebrated on June 9 in the Basilica of St. Chrysogonus where her body is placed, in communion with the entire Trinitarian family scattered throughout the world. The sanctity, of Anna Maria, was recognized for her married life; before her many married women had the honours of the altars, but either they were unmarried, or they were widows or religious, queens or princesses. At the Mass presided over by Fr. Venanzio Di Matteo a number of lay people were admitted to the Trinitarian Laity.

From June 9 to 11, the Assembly of Trinitarian Laity of Southern Spain was held at our house in Villanueva de Arzobispo, Jaén, with the slogan "Reject Christ? Never" Three presentations were given on the figure of Blessed Mark Criado, persecuted Christians and Trinitarian Martyrs.

The topic of the unification of the two laity in Spain was also discussed, for which a positive vote was taken. The timetable is to hold the next General Assembly of the Laity of Spain to update the statutes and to present this unification at the next provincial chapter of the Trinitarians.

Finally, projects submitted to receive financial help from the Laity Redemption Fund were evaluated. Three projects, two of social aid and the third to help persecuted Christians through SIT.




#### SIT General: A young Christian man is convicted over a WhatsApp message in Pakistan.

The situation in Pakistan is getting worse day by day. Moreover, the persecution of Christians reaches social networks, the Internet and chat rooms. On this occasion, the persecution was carried out against a young man, Nouman Asghar, a 24-year-old Christian from the city of Bahawalpur, Punjab, who was sentenced this week to death for blasphemy by a Bahawalpur court of first instance.

The young man had been arrested in 2019 for violation of Article 295-c of the Penal Code, which punishes defamation of the Prophet Muhammad, because of an alleged blasphemy reached via WhatsApp. WhatsApp chat messages containing blasphemous drawings of the Prophet Muhammad were found on the cell phone of the youth and his friend Sunny Mushtaq, who was also detained.

The trial against the youth ended last January, but it took the Bahawalpur Magistrate Court district judge five months to deliver the verdict, which was made public on May 30.



The young man's family denies the charge. According to lawyers, Mushtaq and Asghar received a blasphemous cartoon on their smartphones. However, that drawing was sent to them by Bilal Ahmad, a Muslim youth, but the police took no action against Ahmad, who was the sender of the blasphemous image. "This is another example of the misuse of blasphemy laws," says attorney Anthony, calling on authorities to conduct a fair investigation into the case and announcing an appeal. Authorities continue to bypass the Christian community while Muslims are unfairly protected.

#### Prof. Nicola Calbi, Trinitarian Layman



Prof. Nicola Calbi passed away on May 25, 2023. He was born on January 25, 1934, an outstanding figure, a man in love with the Trinity, of great caliber, a great human, with intellectual and spiritual gifts. He worked hard to innovate the Trinitarian Secular Order, of which he was also president from the early 1980s until 2019, offering his whole self, body and soul, for the building of a mature and solid laity. Prof. Nicholas was a great gift, a valuable light and guide not only for the Laity but also for the whole Trinitarian family. We commend his soul to the infinite mercy of God. RIP

Fr. Joseph Solfizi, of St. John de Matha Province passed away on June 16, 2023. He was born in Cappadocia (AQ), on 12-03-1941.
