several priests and religious from nearby mission centers and the parish community. Fr. Jins Valiyakulathil, O.SS.T. received the vows on behalf of the Vice Provincial Minister. We congratulate the brothers on their courageous step and wish them a peaceful vocational journey.



Italy: S.I.T. Annual Congress



From April 25-27, 2022 the SIT Congress was held in Rome in the hall of the Synod of Bishops at the Vatican, on the theme "Religious Freedom." It was attended by religious men, women and lay people of the entire Trinitarian family from various countries.







It began with a private audience of Pope Francis with the participants of the conference, followed by several lectures with distinguished speakers, such as the Minister General, Spanish journalist Fernando de Haro, Fr. John Bakeni Vicar of the Diocese of Maiduguri, Nigeria, Pablo M. Diez, ABC journalist, and the testimonies of some Trinitarian religious and laity.



It concluded with a prayer vigil for persecuted Christians in the Basilica of St. Chrysogonus in Rome.

This extraordinary meeting was strongly noticeable first of all by the words of Pope Francis, who recalled the specificity of the charism of the Trinitarians, expressing his pleasure in seeing how they were able to actualize this charism of the Order by giving life to the organization of the SIT (International Trinitarian Solidariety), which defends religious freedom in the dual modality of caring for those who are "imprisoned" because of their faith and theoretical deepening also in the academic sphere.



Finally, inviting the members of SIT, to collaborate with other institutions, ecclesial and nonecclesial, that share our "noble purpose," with the recommendation not to lose our specificity by watering down the charism.

Then from the words of the Minister General who reminded that "we cannot and must not forget our brothers and sisters who because of their faith suffer discrimination, violence, and persecution. In some cases, and not a few unfortunately, even death." "Freedom and peace walk together. There is no peace without freedom and vice versa."





One of the significant moments of this convention was the presenting, as a gift, to Pope Francis of the mosaic reproducing the inspiration of our Founder, made by our differently abled friends of our center in Venosa and Bernalda. Another larger mosaic will be given to be placed in the Vatican Gardens.

COPEFAT

The meeting of the Permanent Council of the Trinitarian Family (COPEFAT) was held on April 28 and 29, 2022 at the General Curia of the Trinitarian Fathers in Rome. Minister General, the various Superior Generals from the Trinitarian Sisters, the delegate of the International Laity and the President of the Secretariat of the Trinitarian Family participated. The Federale of the Trinitarian Sisters were unable to attend.



The meeting was held in accordance with the annual meetings of this Family body and included the following: information of all congregations to COPEFAT; presentation of the proposal for a formation group of the whole family; presentation of the upcoming Inter-Trinitarian Assembly 2023; presentation of accounts and various decisions on common activities.



The most important thing about this meeting was the atmosphere of family and closeness that was created.

They shared, presented the difficulties of their jurisdictions, celebrated their faith together,

and joined in a journey marked by a common charism. In this sense, ties with the SIT were strengthened. During the SIT Congress Pope Francis encouraged to continue working together on the path of religious freedom and against the persecution of those who profess their faith in Christ. This session of COPEFAT concluded with the wish that we could be together again on April 12, 2023, in Seville, the starting place of the Assembly of the Trinitarian Family 2023.

Italy: ADEAT Annual Meeting.

The Ordinary Annual Assembly of the Association of Trinitarian Former Students (ADEAT) was held on April 29, 2022, at the Trinitarian House in Via Fontanelle al Trivio in Naples. Association President Vincenzo Morra thanked the members who attended, and the Assembly was chaired by the spiritual leader of the Association, Father Giovanni Savina. Father Rocco Cosi, the provincial gave a talk to those present on the theme of "Synodality."





Synodality, he said, is a choice of life that is based on three fundamental elements: communion, participation and mission. He emphasized that Trinitarians cannot but be synodal, not only because they are religious, but because it is the Rule of the Holy Founder, St. John De Matha, that demands it. All associations, such as L'ADEAT, which originate from the Trinitarian Order, cannot fail to live the same way of life desired by the Holy Founder.

He invited, therefore, ADEAT members to live these dimensions with the whole Trinitarian family. The Minister General of the Order, Fr. Luigi Buccarello, did not want to miss the 'assembly. The presence of Minister General always proves edifying and productive. He urged all members to exchange life experiences and walk together with the whole Trinitarian family.



France: Mayor of Valence hands over a coat of arms to the Trinitarian Religious of Valence

The mother house of the Trinitarian Religious of Valence, which was over three centuries old, was demolished in 2021. At the beginning of May 2022, Benjamin Misery, General Director of Sénioriales, and Nicolas Daragon, Mayor of Valence, handed over to the congregation their emblem, which was extracted from its facade.

This piece of history of the city of Valence and the congregation will reach the museum of the Trinitarian sisters in Lyon in the coming days.



Spain: Blessed Mark Criado, Martyr



The Jubilee Year that commemorates the fifth centenary of the birth of Blessed Mark Criado began on May 8, in the Church of the Trinitarian Nuns in Andújar, with a solemn Eucharistic celebration presided over by the Bishop of Jaén and concelebrated by the Minister General, the Minister Provincial and various religious of the Holy Spirit Province. Provincia Spirito Santo, si è dato inizio all'anno giubilare per ricordare il quinto centenario della nascita del Beato Marco Criado. On May 12, the City Council of Andújar unanimously approved in an extraordinary session the posthumous designation of the Beloved Son, Blessed Mark Criado, an Andujareño religious who was martyred in the Granada municipality of La Peza in 1569. And on May 22, 2022, Andújar City Day, Blessed Marco, in an institutional act, was officially declared the Beloved Son of the City of Andújar by the Mayor and the entire city.









Inter-Trinitarian Assembly 2023: Preparatory Team Meeting.

Adhering to the decision of 2021 COPEFAT, the 2023 Assembly meeting will be held in the form of a pilgrimage along the path of redemption, a committee was formed to take charge of the organization and logistics. In fact, on May 12, 2022 at Father Méndez's Trinitarian house in Seville, we were able to meet the team for the first time in the presence of Fr. Antonio Aurelio, president of the Secretariat for the Family, Fr. Pedro Aliaga (absent), Fr. Ignacio Rojas, Fr. Francesco Prontera Sister Teresita (absent), Mary Simone (Valence),



María José Echeverria (Valencia), Rosalía Tejo (Majorca), María Ángeles Molina, (Madrid) José Arenas (Laicado) and Cofeduardo Coto (Cofradías Trinitarias). The necessary committees were created so that this assembly would take place as a family gathering. Each has taken responsibility for one of them and at the same time will create its corresponding team.



Given the difficulty of such an assembly, registration will begin soon.Congratulations to this team who willingly volunteered their time, experience and knowledge. This is from the vocation of service to the whole family and Holy Trinity.

Sisters of the Most Holy Trinity of Madrid: Mother Mariana of the Most Holy Trinity, Venerable



On May 21, during the audience granted to the prefect of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, Pope Francis authorized the Congregation to promulgate the Decree concerning the heroic virtues of the Servant of God Mariana of the Most Holy Trinity, co-founder of the institute of the Trinitarian Sisters of Madrid together with Father Francisco de Asís Méndez Casariego on Feb. 2, 1885.

Spain: Trinitarian Family Formation Session.

The formation session of the Trinitarian family in Spain was celebrated on May 19 and 21, 2022. This meeting was attended not only by members of the Trinitarian family of Spain but also those from other countries.

Spain: Formation and Witness of Trinitarian Laity in Algeciras

France: Remembrance Of Br. Marc Villa



In memory of Fr. Marc Villa, a French Trinitarian religious who died on May 20 and was buried on May 25, a Mass was celebrated for his soul on June 3 in the presence of all French religious of the Order in the Cerfroid Chapter Hall with the participation of men and women religious, Trinitarian laity and other faithful.



The Vicar Minister, Fr. Roger Matton, who presided at the Eucharist, along with other religious absent from the funeral, took the opportunity to pay tribute to Fr. Marc, to thank the Lord for the gift he was and to entrust his soul to the mercy of God the Trinity.

France: Meeting of French Religious

A meeting of all French religious of the General Vicariate Sacred Heart of Jesus (Canada-France) was held in Cerfroid on June 3-4. They came from Faucon (France), Moyen Orient, Cerfroid (France) and Rome.







This was convened to work on some issues related to the situation in France and was chaired by the Vicariate Minister of the said jurisdiction, Fr. Roger Matton. At the end of this meeting, Fr. Loic Huyghues-Despointes was elected Legal Representative for France.

France: General Congregation Of The Order

The Domus Trinitatis in Cerfroid, the cradle of the Order, hosted the General Congregation of the Order from June 7 to 12. It was attended by the Minister General and his Council, as well as all the Major Ministers of the different jurisdictions (Provinces, Vice Provinces and Vicariates). They were days of fraternity and work to evaluate what was made of the decisions of the 2019 General Chapter and to reflect on issues that affect the life of the Order and the Trinitarian family.



The sharing that followed in the various sessions allowed for updates, clarification of various situations, edification of the participants, and some decisions. This General Congregation wanted to place an emphasis on formation, especially the accompaniment of young religious.









In this regard, the intervention during the General Congregation, of Fr. Amedeo Cencini, a Canosian religious, teacher at the Pontifical Salesian University in Rome, psychotherapist, and author of numerous publications, on the theme: "The first years after solemn profession and priestly ordination," gave many insights that helped and oriented the reflectionOther highlights of this General Congregation were the guided tour of the Cathedral of Reims and especially the celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity in the Chapter House of Cerfroid with all the authorities of the Order and the Trinitarian family.

On the occasion of this solemn and heartfelt celebration, presided over by the Minister General, as usual, all Trinitarian religious men, women and laymen renewed their vows and consecration to the Trinity. A lunch with the whole Trinitarian family was held at the conclusion of the celebration.











Madrid: The Eve of the Holy Trinity

On the afternoon of Saturday, June 11, the eve of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, the Madrid Trinitarian Family gathered at the Madrid Echegaray Trinitarian House to pray and celebrate the Eucharist.
