


Rome: Trinitarian Family Retreat

On Saturday, April 1, 2023, the Retreat of the Trinitarian Family was held in Rome, at the General Curia, directed by Fr. Javier Carnerero Penalver, Procurator and Postulator General of the Order, in the presence of all the members of the Trinitarian Family of Rome. The meeting was held in two parts: reflection and Eucharistic adoration.







International Trinitarian Assembly

From 12 to 19 April 2023, the International Trinitarian Assembly was held. This year it took place in a different way, it was a pilgrimage Assembly through some cities of Spain and Morocco, in which several members of Trinitarian Family participated: religious men and women and lay Trinitarians who came from 22 countries. After Seville, where the Assembly opened, they travelled to Algeciras, in the extreme south of Spain,





then by sea to Tangier, in Morocco, continuing to Rabat, the capital, then on to Fez and Meknes, before returning to Seville, Spain.

In this way it was possible to recall the first redemptions to draw from the roots a new sap to update the Trinitarian charism in this time, in all the places where we are called to cooperate.

The participants were able to reflect and meditate on the theme:

"The imprint of the Redeemers: Vocation and identity", it was a very enriching week of prayer, discussion and sharing for the representatives of the Trinitarian Family spread around the world. A synodal experience for the Trinitarian Family.



These are the suggestions and proposals that emerged from the reflections of the various groups:

- 1. Promote specific charismatic formation "in the family", Biblical the deepening foundations and the historical origins of the Trinitarian charism, highlighting the specific of our charismatic aspects identity, with suitable means and initiatives (lectio divina on the Biblical texts that speak of redemption, deepening the historical and social context in which our Founder lived, etc.).
- 2. Highlight the need for greater preparation in the field of interreligious and intercultural dialogue: a real challenge for the Church especially in contexts where it is a minority.









- 3. Recognize the primacy of concrete action in favor of those persecuted for the faith through SIT to offer a contagious witness of our charism.
- 4. Consolidate and expand our presence in territories where Christians are persecuted, adequately preparing those who will carry out their mission permanently in these territories.
- 5. To grow in the spirit of the family and unity in the diversity of specific vocations, walking in synodality, leaving out pyramidal systems and self-referential temptations, implementing a style of circularity and humility. Fraternal communion is our first mission and the greatest witness we can offer the world.













- 6. Promote devotion to the redeemed Jesus Nazarene in the different cultures.
- 7. Our communities and lay fraternities to be open to all, especially the young: to involve them as protagonists, favoring concrete and meaningful experiences of our charismatic commitment.
- 8. Promote more effective communication both within the Trinitarian Family and externally. To make Trinitarian spirituality and works known through the good use of modern means of communication to widen our network of solidarity.

Seville-Spain: SIT Meeting

The board of the SIT General, as every year, met on 11 April in Seville on the eve of the International Trinitarian Assembly. On this occasion the Trinitarian Family reaffirmed its determination to stand by persecuted Christians.

Several projects were approved to help our brothers and sisters suffering persecution in India, Syria, Nigeria, Iraq, Cuba and Sudan.

Spain: Testimony of Sister Teresa Olano Gonzalez

Sister Teresa Olano Gonzalez, a nun of the Trinitarian Order tells us at 95 years of age about her long experience in the service of prisoners. An experience she shares with all those who work in this field.

After almost thirty years of weekly visits to prisoners in Seville, Sister Teresa says that to carry out a good pastoral ministry in prison, one must listen a lot and speak little, have a lot of patience and humility. The last thing to ask prisoners is the reason for their sentence, and this discretion is much appreciated by them. The really important thing is to convey the Lord's mercy and his word of salvation and deliverance.



Antequera-Spain: Enlarged General Council

The Enlarged General Council was held in Antequera, Spain on 20-22 April 2023, attended by the Minister General and his Council and all the Major Ministers of the various jurisdictions (Provinces, Vice Province and Vicariates). The city was chosen because it is a reference point for the Order in Spain with Prolibertas as an example.

The Enlarged General Council arrived in Antequera on the morning of 20 April, with a reception by the mayor of the city, Mr. Manuel Jesus Baron Rios, who presented the city of Antequera and gave the guests a tour of the significant administrative sites of the municipality. He thanked the Trinitarians for their involvement in the life of the city. The meeting ended with an exchange of gifts, from the mayor to all the religious present and from the Minister General to the mayor on behalf of the Order. In the afternoon, the work of the Enlarged General Council began at our convent.

They were days of fraternity and work with the aim of updating each other on the situations and problems concerning the various jurisdictions and the Order as a whole, and of sharing on projects.









France: Pastoral Visit

From 2 to 15 May 2023, the Minister General made his pastoral visit to France, accompanied by Fr. Carmel Gladys Ulrich Dinamona, Secretary General of the Order. He visited the houses of Faucon, Paris and Cerfroid, respectively. He passed through Aix-enprovence and Angouleme. In addition to the religious, he met the Trinitarian sisters of Rome (Faucon) and Valencia (Faucon, Forcalquier, Paris, Angouleme and Cerfroid), thanking them for their presence and service. He also met with groups of lay people, priests associated with our religious family, to whom he described the situation of the Order and its evolution, its new frontiers and its challenges. On this occasion, he was also able to hear testimonies of conversion and commitment to evangelization.
