BRIEF NEWS

Rome: Conference at the General Curia on the Trinitarian artist, Br. Joseph of St. Teresa.



On June 19, a conference was held in the Council Chamber of the General Curia. Professor of Art History, Mirosława Sboczynska-Szczepanska, of the University of Silesia in Katowice (Poland) presented the paintings of the Trinitarian artist, Brother Joseph of St. Teresa (Joseph Precht, Vienna 1737- Brańków 1799). Of Austrian origin, the young Joseph attended the Academy of Fine Arts in Vienna before coming to Poland where he joined the Polish-Lithuanian Trinitarian Province in Lviv in 1754. As a lay brother, he was able to meet many local artists and express his art in paintings and frescoes in Trinitarian churches and private palaces. His works are still admired in churches and museums in different places in Poland, Belorussia, and Ukraine.

Professor Mirosława, a specialist in Baroque architecture, published her research in 2017 on Trinitarian architecture in the Polish-Lithuanian confederation or Republic of Two Nations (*Architektura trynitarzy na ziemiach dawnej Rzeczypospolitej*, 2017) and several articles in English and Spanish.

Transit of the few mortal remains of Mother Maria Teresa Cucchiari.





Since July 31, 2021, the mortal remains of Mother Maria Teresa Cucchiari, Foundress of the Trinitarian Sisters of Rome, have been resting in a beautiful urn in the parish of San Giovanni in Avezzano (AQ). A place so dear to all the sisters, because this city was the first field of action in which Mother Maria Teresa Cucchiari worked for forty years and from which the Institute developed, from the distant 1762 until today and, if God the Trinity wills it, even beyond.....

For this important anniversary there was a Solemn Concelebration presided by the Apostolic Administrator, Mons. Pietro Santoro, the Most Reverend Father General, the Vicar General, other Trinitarian confreres, the parish priests where the Trinitarian Sisters carry out their apostolate, with the numerous participations of Trinitarian laity, the faithful and the political and civil authorities of Marsica.

Madrid (Spain) Meeting of COPEFAT.



Every year the Permanent Council of the Trinitarian Family meets to deal with topics corresponding to the life of the Family. Unfortunately, due to the health emergency that exists for almost two years, it was impossible to meet. In July of this year, in Madrid, COPEFAT met once again. Present were

the Father General, the Federal Mother of the Trinitarian Sisters, the Mothers General of the Trinitarians of Valence, Valencia, Majorca, the Vicar General of Madrid and the President of the Trinitarian Laity. They discussed the situation being experienced in relation to vocations, the statutes of the International Laity and the next Inter-Trinitarian Assembly to be held in 2023. What marked the meeting was an environment of true family, sincerity and affection. Everyone felt like true members, with the dignity of feeling united for the common good. At the end, with the words of Father General, Christians who suffer persecution because of their faith in Christ were remembered.

India: Temporary Professions of Trinitarian Sisters of Madrid

July 26 was a great day for the Trinitarian Sisters of Madrid, especially in India. For the first time in this country three of their novices professed their vows. The ceremony took place in the Church dedicated to the Holy Trinity, in Trissur.

The Eucharist was presided over by the Vice Provincial, Rev. Fr. Joseph Muthupplackkal O.S.S.T, in the presence of Sr. Alphonsa Veliyath T.S, Superior of the Trinitarian Sisters in India, who received the vows in the name of the Superior General, Sr. Felicia Fernandez. We are grateful for the vocations of Sr. Sona Biju, Sr. Nillu Parichha and Sr. Jismaria Sajan.





Saints Cosmas and Damian (Italy): Feast of St. Anne



The parish community of Campomaggiore, given the improvement in the health situation, was able to celebrate the feast of St. Anne this year. Preceded by a nine-day preparation, the feast was marked essentially by the Solemn Concelebration of the Eucharist. Due to the restrictions related to Covid-19, there was not the usual procession, however the priests accompanied the statue of St. Anne, placed on a car, through the streets of the village.



Diocese of Port Bergé (Madagascar): Inauguration: of a New Church, Community and School.



Sunday, August 8, 2021, was a great day for the Province of Our Lady of Good Remedy and for the diocese of Port Bergé in Madagascar, because it was marked by a triple inauguration of the new Church, the new Trinitarian Community, and the New School (all three named after the Holy Trinity). It all began with the blessing of the new Church. During the Eucharistic celebration, the bishop proclaimed the

creation of the new parish and officially appointed Fr. Samuel Rakotovao O.S.S.T., as the first new parish priest. Jean Claude Herménégilde, Minister Provincial, spoke about the Order and its missions in the world and in Madagascar. The Mass was well attended, and the Church was packed with people. Twenty-five priests concelebrated; about forty men and women religious were present, and about thirty lay Trinitarians from all over the island honored this beautiful feast with their participation. On the same occasion, the bishop had the joy of baptizing 24 children from the newly erected parish.



After the Eucharistic celebration, the bishop also blessed the new school and consecrated the altar of the new Trinitarian community. Our friars have been serving this locality since January 28 of this year, the feast of St. Agnes. Everything then ended with a very lively fraternal agape. May the Holy Trinity always assist this new reality entrusted to you and the entire Order.
