## Spain: National Assembly of the Trinitarian Family.

From November 19 to 21, the Assembly of the Trinitarian Family of Spain was held in Madrid. On the first day, the participants gathered to celebrate Vespers and for a fellowship. Fr. Isidoro Murciego presented the theme "35 years as a Trinitarian Family: lights and shadows". Fr. Isidoro gave an ample and long overview of what the meetings of the entire Family have been over the years. He helped those present to remember things that perhaps they had forgotten.

He introduced those present to the original spirit of the Inter-Trinitarian Assemblies of the Family and aroused the desire to continue to walk together, united. Afterwards, a round table was held in which the Trinitarians of Madrid, the Young Trinitarians, the confraternities and FEST (Holy Trinity Educational Foundation) participated. Also relevant was the intervention of Fr. Antonio Aurelio, President of the General Secretariat for the Order's Trinitarian Family.



He illustrated how we can give continuity to these Assemblies, that is, by participating in the Inter Trinitarian Assembly of 2023. It will be a synodal Assembly, that is, we will all walk together, retracing the historical path of redemption (from Spain to Morocco). It will be a path that will follow the steps of our first redemptive fathers. In this regard, Fr. Antonio stressed how important it is to have a spirit of humility, recognizing that we are neither the origin nor the beginning of anything, but that our brothers had already opened the way for us



Two panel discussions followed. The first was composed of the Trinitarian religious, the Trinitarians of Valencia, the laity and the SIT. Here it was noted that SIT is the organism that unites the entire Family and identifies it in its apostolic activity. In SIT we all find ourselves and we all participate. Hence the desire to continue to support and promote it. The second-round table was made up of the Trinitarians of Valencia, the Contemplative Sisters and the Trinitarians of Mallorca.







In the end, on November 21, they reflected on the future of the Trinitarian Family, that is, to work through the challenges presented to us in order to offer clear proposals that will help us to walk, each with its own identity, forming a whole that identifies us, which, ultimately, is the image of the Trinity.
