Banner of the Secular Trinitarian Order of Italy

The banner is a symbol of the Essence of the National Secular Order of the Trinitarian Laity, made by the artist painter Corbi Maurizio with acrylic technique on satin; it is presented as a symbolic image evoking the arduous Christian task of the Secular Order. The pictorial composition shows clearly in the center of the scene enclosed in a triangle of light reminiscent of the Holy Trinity; a cross, a sign of the faith of men, which manages to destroy and completely deteriorate the earthly and materialistic slavery in the world, symbolized by the lucidity and well-defined chain. At the top of the entire composition, are also placed: the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end, to remember and exalt the commitment and steadfastness that the Order of the Trinitarian Laity has taken on and will continue until the end of time.

On Sunday, the Word of God preached by Pope Francis in September 2019, had a special echo this year in the temporary detention center of Mogi and Suzano in São Paulo (Brazil). In fact, our confreres engaged in prison ministry in São Paulo, along with Postulants, received on September 21, 2020, as a gift of Bibles from the Pauline Cooperators Association for the Evangelization of Prisons of the Diocese of Mogi Das Cruzes (São Paulo). Bibles that were distributed to prisoners on September 23, 2020.

September 19, Rome: Deacon and Priestly Ordinations..

On Saturday, September 19, 2020, the Province of St. John de Matha celebrated the diaconal ordinations of Br. Bienvenu Ntondele Diouabaka (Congo) and Br. Ulrich Fredy Moundounga Moundounga (Gabon) and the priestly ordination of Br. Domenico Pham The Vihn (Vietnam) in the Parish of Santa Maria delle Grazie at Fornaci in Rome. The Holy Mass was presided, with the laying on of hands and consecratory prayer, by H.E. Most Reverend José Rodriguez Carballo, O.F.M. Secretary of the Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life.

We wish the new deacons and the new priest that the grace of the Sacrament of Orders received, with the intercession of our Holy Founders John and Felix and especially with the help of the Blessed Virgin Mary Mother of Good Remedy, will accompany and support them in their ministry.

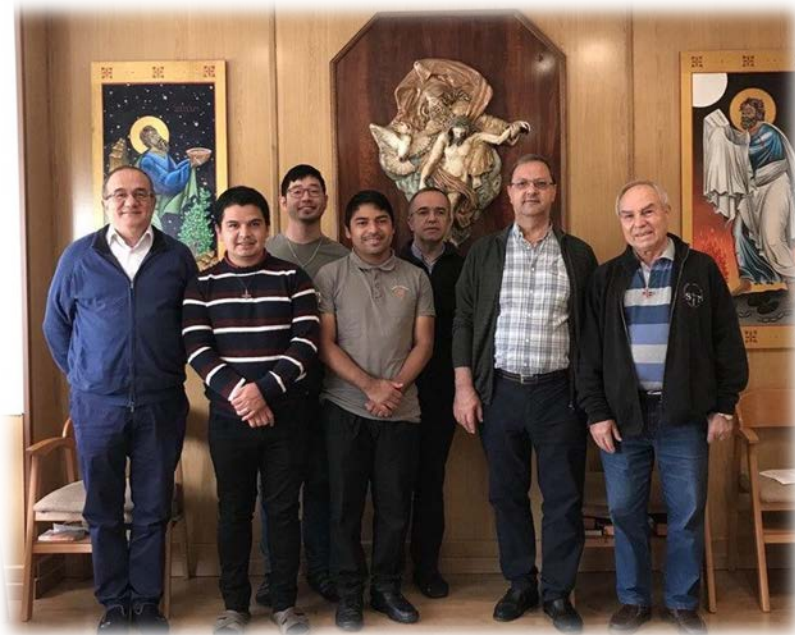

The eternal rest to the soul of Sister Virtudes de Jesús María Muro Torres of the Community of the Trinitarian Sisters of Martos (Spain) who died on July 25, 2020. Born in Alcalá la Real (Jaén) on October 9, 1929, to very Christian parents, Antonio Muro and Concepción Torres, Sister Virtudes was the eldest of four brothers. She entered the convent of Trinitarians of Alcalá la Real on August 12, 1947 at the age of 18. She took the Holy Habit on January 19, 1948 and made her Simple Profession on April 19, 1948. She made her Solemn Profession on June 29, 1951.

She entered the community of Martos on September 9, 1977. During her life in the monastery she has carried out various assignments, Vicar, sacristan, bursar, in recent years she has been counselor. She was also a teacher and taught embroidery to women and girls. She was loved by all who knew her, for her simplicity and she was very affectionate. She loved the community very much and let herself be loved by everyone. Even though she was 90 years old, she worked tirelessly all her life and collaborated until the last. She always saw the positive side of each one. For 10 years, she was in a wheelchair and had lost her sight. Nevertheless, she participated in the whole life of the community and never wanted to be late. Sr. Marie-Léonie's life was "enveloped" by her love for the Virgin Mary. Every day she recited Holy Rosary even during the night. Now, she saw it face to face. It is her most beautiful reward. R.I.P.

Sister Maria Méndez Benavides (Mercedes)



Sister Maria Mendez Benavides (Mercedes) of the Community of the Trinitarian Sisters of Martos (Spain) returned to the Father on September 7, 2020 at 04.25 am. Born in Barca Rota (Badajoz) on March 26, 1929 to very Christian parents, José Méndez and Isabel Benavides. Sister Mercedes was the youngest of three brothers. She entered the Trinitarian Convent of Badajoz on January 15, 1947 at the age of 18. She took the Holy habit on July 16, 1947. She made her simple profession on March 30, 1949 and solemn profession on April 1, 1952. She moved to the community of Martos on August 14, 1981.

She was a missionary in Madagascar in 1988 but for health problems she returned to the community of Martos in 1993. During her life in the monastery she performed various functions and services: vicar, novice mistress, bursar and seamstress. She had much love for her Order and for her Contemplative Trinitarian Vocation. A special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and to his beloved Blessed Mother Frances of the Incarnation.
