Spain: Solemn Profession of Sister Juana Francisca Rasoanirina



The convent Church of the Trinitarian Nuns celebrated the Solemn Profession of Sister Juana Francisca Rasoanirina during the Mass of the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of Mary. On this very day, five years ago, Sister Juana made her first vows of poverty, chastity and obedience, for the glory of the Trinity and the redemption of the captives in this monastery in Burgos, "dedicated - as the profession formula says - only to God in solitude and silence, in assiduous prayer and generous penance, according to the Constitutions of the nuns of the Order of the Most Holy Trinity."

Sister Juana Francisca Rasoanirina, who comes from a very religious family in Madagascar with several children and grandchildren consecrated to God, made her perpetual profession before Mother Prioress Mercedes Tajadura and the Order's Minister General, Fr. Luigi Buccarello, who presided over the celebration. They were accompanied by some religious of the Trinitarian Order, the Episcopal Delegate for Consecrated Life, Fr. Amadeo Alonso SDB,

the chaplain, Juan María González Oña, and some priest friends of the community. Also present were sisters from other communities, relatives of the sister, and many friends of the community.



San Carlino-Rome: APPS 2024.

MEDEA-Italy: General Economic Council.



From January 24 to 25, the Enlarged General Council for Finance met in Medea, Italy, presided over by the General Treasurer. The meeting was attended by the Treasurer of the Province of St. John de Matha (Italy-Poland-Austria-Mexico-Vietnam), the Treasurer of the Province of the Holy Spirit

(Spain-Morocco-South Korea), the Treasurer of the Province Immaculate Heart of Mary (USA-Philippines), the Treasurer of the Province Our Lady of Good Remedy (Madagascar), the Vice-Province St. Michael of the Saints (India), and the Vicariate General Sacred Heart of Jesus (Canada-France). The Minister General, connected via the web, greeted the participants, and thanked them for the work they do in their jurisdiction.

Manila-Philippines: Trinitarian Women Religious of Rome.

Trinitarian women religious from Rome and Manila, Philippines, are engaged in prison ministry. They provide inspiration and support to prisoners by encouraging them to make positive changes and pursue personal growth. Additionally, they assist inmates in introspection, helping them recognize mistakes and commit to a path of transformation.



Bahrain's King Hamad Bin Isa Al Khalifa meets Bishop Aldo Berardi



On January 30, 2024, King Hamad Bin Isa Al Khalifa of the Kingdom of Bahrain received the Apostolic Vicar of Northern Arabia, Bishop Aldo Berardi, in the Offices of the Royal Palace in Manama. Bishop Berardi was accompanied by the Rector of the Cathedral of Our Lady of Arabia, Fr. Saji Thomas, OFM Cap., in the presence of several Ministers. Among the highlights of the visit, King Hamad emphasized the joy of his meetings with Pope Francis, first in Bahrain in November 2022 (see Fides Agency 2/11/2022), and then during his reception at the Vatican in October 2023. The King praised Pope Francis for his wisdom and steadfast support of peace worldwide. During the meeting, discussions revolved around the means of consolidating the culture of dialogue, tolerance, religious moderation, and the rejection of extremism and fanaticism. King Hamad appreciated and emphasized the importance of good relations and cooperation with the Catholic Church, as well as the value of the coexistence of different religions. Bishop Aldo extended an invitation to King Hamad to visit the Cathedral and expressed gratitude for his support of the various religions represented in Bahrain without discrimination. He also commended the provision of places of worship, emphasizing the Kingdom's efforts in spreading the values of peace and coexistence. As a tribute to the King, the Bishop presented a picture framed in Rome in a 19th-century frame. The picture showcased one of the earliest maps of the Arabian Peninsula dating back to 1658, featuring Bahrain prominently.

Salamanca-Spain: Trinitarian International Meeting on Prison Pastoral Work.



At the initiative of the General Secretariat for the Apostolate, from February 6 to 8, Trinitarian religious and laypeople from different corners of the world gathered to address the challenges and opportunities offered by pastoral work in prisons. Representing the different realities of our Order, the participants shared experiences and drew conclusions that point to the future of this important work.

This pastoral work, rooted in Mercy and the Redeeming Trinity, emerges as a tangible manifestation of shared life in the Trinitarian family. It stands on the pillars of compassion and redemption, reflecting the unwavering commitment of Trinitarians and Trinitarian women to serve those in situations of vulnerability and exclusion. The unity and solidarity that characterize the Trinitarian community provide a solid foundation for this work, inspired by the love and justice emanating from the Triune God.

Among the highlighted conclusions is an assessment of the work done so far in the Order in the area of prison ministry.

The support of the Church and its bishops, who recognize this mission as integral to the Trinitarian charism, is acknowledged. Additionally, the significant contribution this work represents to both the Church and society at large is emphasized.



There is a strong emphasis on the importance of teamwork and involving the entire Trinitarian community in chaplaincy, rather than limiting this responsibility solely to the chaplain. The need to continue raising awareness among all members of the Order about the relevance of this pastoral care and to develop actions that strengthen prevention and reintegration after prison are also highlighted. One of the most crucial points of the conclusions is the proposal for a serious reflection at the level of the Order

on prison ministry, ensuring that it is grounded in the Trinitarian charism and established as an international priority. is an urgent need to make a firm and shared commitment to be redeemers for freedom, following the example of John de Matha, and to share life and mission as a Trinitarian family. The Trinitarian International Meeting on Prison Pastoral Care concluded with the presence of Don José Luis Retana, bishop of Salamanca and Ciudad Rodrigo.

Esperia-Italy: 60th anniversary of priesthood of Father Bruno Palazzo



On Sunday, February 25, 2024, in the Parish of St. Mary Major and St. Philip Neri in Esperia, a Mass of thanksgiving was celebrated for the 60th priestly anniversary of Father Bruno Palazzo, Parish Priest of Esperia. The celebration was presided over by Bishop Monsignor Gerardo Antonazzo and concelebrated by the Minister Provincial Father Rocco Cosi, Secretary and General Councilor of the Trinitarian Order Father Carmel Dinamona and many other diocesan and religious priests aided by a small group of ministrants coordinated by Assistant Pastor Father Servais Madiki.
